**MUSTARD SEED 2000 -2005 SCHOLARSHIP FUND:**

By the year 2005, we hope to have awarded 2005 "Mustard Seed Scholarships". The Scholarships will enable many children, young people, women and diaconal workers to participate, many for the first time, in an ecumenical course or programme.

**CROSS +ROADS RESOURCE and STUDY CENTRE:**

ENYA has establishing a multi-lingual Central and Eastern European Resource Centre, in Prague. By the year 2005, it is committed to reaching the target of (at least) 20,000 books - 4000 in each of the following subject areas - Youth and Community Work, Diaconal Work, Women's Work, Christian Education and Ecumenical Studies.

**CHURCHES COMPUTERS SHAREWARE PROGRAMME:**

The Computer Shareware Programme is a project which aims to assist Churches, women's organisations, theological faculties, diaconal projects, youth organisations, parishes, and the new lay academies in Eastern and Central Europe in acquiring urgently needed technology which will enable them to further develop their capacity to respond to the many pressing needs which are facing them.

**DETSKY DOMOV (CHILDREN'S HOMES) VENTURES - CHURCHES SUPPORT LINK:**

These initiatives promote a greater involvement of the Churches in developing projects and increasing the needed provisions for the support of children and youth who are in state resident care institutions and centres. Ventures include feasibility studies for the establishment of purpose built therapeutic group homes, and specialised programmes targeted to the needs of the young people - Prevent Trafficking, Forced Prostitution, and Sexual Abuse, the Clothes and Shoes Fund, Christmas Presents Projects, Sports and Camping Equipment Projects, Bicycle Kolo Programme, Roma School Scholarship Programme, and the Musical Instruments/Culture Initiative, to name a few.

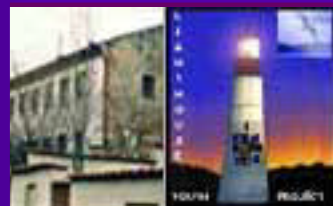
**CHURCHES SOLIDARITY PROGRAMME

Developing partnership with young Roma / Sinti young people is a priority programme within ENYA. Roma/Sinti communities make up the largest minority group in Europe today. Between 5-6 million Roma/Sinti people live in Eastern and Central

Europe. Being a Roma/Sinti young person in Europe today means facing every day discrimination, often violence and threats of violence, unemployment, social injustice, facing the prejudices and the negative image that our society has, only because Roma/Sinti belong to a different culture, because they have different values, a different ethnic background, a different name and sometimes a darker colour of skin. Many Roma children throughout the Eastern and Central European region continue to be denied the opportunity to reach their full potential. The ENYA ROMA YOUTH INITIATIVES enable young people to develop their own response to these injustices to find new empowering ways within their communities towards combatting the worst forms of racism and discrimination in solidarity with the ENYA network.

**LIGHTHOUSE YOUTH HOMES**



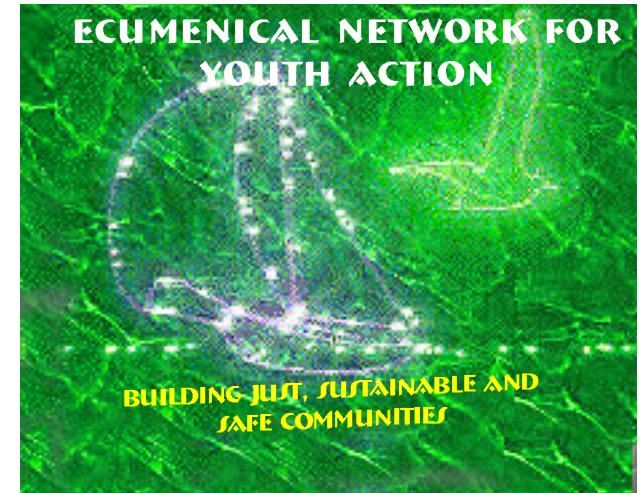

The Ecumenical Diploma Programmes takes about two years to complete. Participants attend a month long Foundation Course and a minimum of 4 Modules (usually two each year - 7 to 10 days), plus other options. 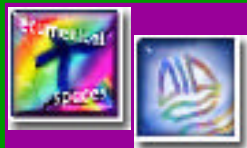

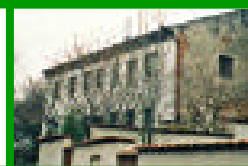

### ENYA INTERNSHIPS:

Send application form along with curriculum vitae and indicate what internship you are applying for.

Each year, with the help of our ecumenical partners and donor agencies, ENYA co-manages several internships. The internships generally last from 1 month to 12 months and can take place throughout Eastern and Central Europe. Accommodation and food plus pocket money is provided and travel scholarships are also available for those from CEE. ENYA also offers a further internship placement service by linking people who are interested in doing volunteer work with a diaconal project or lay / reconciliation centre. Internships are generally related to diaconal or social injustice concerns, language skills training, or capacity building, though manual project work proposals will also be considered. This year there will be placements in the following programmes.
